During the COVID-19 pandemic, Otto, then an underclassman with GIGi, an emotional support dog (see the photo of Otto/GiGi on the website images section) delivered food packages to cancer survivors living alone under the shelter-in-place order in San Francisco, California. In 2021, he received the Humanitarian Award from Prostate Cancer Resource, a 501 (c)(3) non-profit agency founded 25 years ago, for risking his life to help cancer survivors and others facing hunger. Otto was actively involved with Israel's Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's Office, COGAT, and non-government humanitarian agencies located in Northern Gaza seeking safe passage for the Christian evacuees.
